Decentralized Clinical Trials (DCTs) are clinical trials where some or all of the trial-related activities occur at locations other than traditional hospital settings.

In full DCTs, all activities take place at locations other than

### traditional hospital settings.

In hybrid DCTs, <u>some</u> trial activities involve in-person visits by trial participants to traditional hospital settings, and <u>some</u> activities are conducted at other locations.

Examples of DCT activities are: laboratory tests conducted by remote clinical laboratory facilities (e.g. LabCorp/Quest), telehealth, home visits from providers, digital health technologies (e.g. wearables), using local HCPs for research-related activities
